City of Adelaide in partnership with the SALA Festival is again offering artists an artist fee subsidy in 2019. This scheme acknowledges the role that artists and local venues play in the cultural life of the council area. Subsidies of \$120 are available to assist individuals and groups with the cost of registering for the SALA Festival.

Subsidies will be provided to artists who are exhibiting **within the City of Adelaide area** (and may or may not be residents of the City).

Subsidies will only be provided for costs associated with registrations for SALA, and will be provided to the **first 30 applications received**.

Artists must:

- Register for SALA via the online form by May 13 2019
- Pay the relevant fee to SALA
- Fill out the form found in the resources section of the SALA website with a copy of the e-receipt received after payment and return to SALA, via email or post.

Multiple applications may be considered. **The closing date for applications will be May 20 2019.**

Applications will be dated in order of receipt, and no correspondence will be entered into until the closing of applications on May 20. **Successful applicants will be advised from May 27 2019.** Please see the application form on the SALA website for details.

The **City of Marion** is continuing its involvement with the SALA Festival by supporting and promoting emerging and professional artists involved in the annual event. Council is supporting local artists taking part in the Festival by subsidising artist registrations with a \$120 capped rebate. Artists who do not reside within Marion but who wish to register an exhibition in the Council area are also eligible to claim the rebate. "The City of Marion" must be included **under 'Tax Invoice Information'** on the SALA registration form when completing.

The **City of Burnside** is offering artists a SALA registration subsidy.

This scheme acknowledges the role that artists and local venues play in the cultural life of the council area. **Subsidies of up to \$120** are available to assist individuals and groups with the cost of registering for the SALA Festival.

Subsidies will be provided to artists who are:

- residents of the City of Burnside who are exhibiting either in or outside of the Council area.
- Artists exhibiting within City of Burnside required to pay a SALA fee direct to SALA (e.g. does not include exhibitions in venues which pay the SALA fee on the artists behalf, such as the Pepper street Arts Centre).

Subsidies will only be provided for costs associated with registrations for SALA. Exact allocation of subsidies will be dependent upon the number of applications received.

To apply for the SALA Subsidy artists must:

- **Register for SALA via their online form, by the SALA deadline;**
- **Pay the relevant fee to SALA;**
- **Fill out the City of Burnside Application (<https://bit.ly/2MTwLgo>)**
- **Include a copy of the SALA registration receipt (must be in the resident's name).**

The closing date for applications will be **Monday 20 May 2019**.

Applications will be dated in order of receipt, and no correspondence will be entered into.

- Subsidies will only be provided for costs associated with registrations for SALA 2019
- Subsidies are available to any artists exhibiting at local venues within the City of Holdfast Bay
- Allocation of subsidies will be dependent on the number of applications received
