City of Adelaide in partnership with the SALA Festival is again offering artists an artist fee subsidy in 2018. This scheme acknowledges the role that artists and local venues play in the cultural life of the council area. Subsidies of \$120 are available to assist individuals and groups with the cost of registering for the SALA Festival.

Subsidies will be provided to artists who are exhibiting **within the City of Adelaide area** (and may or may not be residents of the City).

Subsidies will only be provided for costs associated with registrations for SALA, and will be provided to the **first 30 applications received**.

Artists must:

- Register for SALA via the online form by May 14 2018
- Pay the relevant fee to SALA
- Fill out the form found in the resources section of the SALA website with a copy of the e-receipt received after payment and return to SALA, via email or post.

Multiple applications may be considered. **The closing date for applications will be May 21 2018.**

Applications will be dated in order of receipt, and no correspondence will be entered into until the closing of applications on May 22. **Successful applicants will be advised from May 28 2018.** Please see the application form on the SALA website for details.

City of Adelaide is proud to support the SALA Festival and acknowledges that the festival fosters creativity, cultural and artistic events and activities. Artists receiving subsidies will be requested to display the City of Adelaide logo on any printed material acknowledging the support.

The **City of Marion** is continuing its involvement with the SALA Festival by supporting and promoting emerging and professional artists involved in the annual event. Council is supporting local artists taking part in the Festival by subsidising artist registrations with a \$120 capped rebate. Artists who do not reside within Marion but who wish to register an exhibition in the Council area are also eligible to claim the rebate. "The City of Marion" must be included under 'Tax Invoice Information' on the SALA registration form when completing.

Subsidies will be provided to artists who are:

- residents of the City of Unley who are exhibiting either in or outside of the Council area
- artists exhibiting within the City of Unley

Subsidies will only be provided for costs associated with registrations for SALA. Multiple applications may be considered.

The closing date for applications will be **15 May 2018**. Exact allocation of subsidies will be dependent upon the number of applications received.

Subsidies of up to \$120 are available to assist individuals and groups with the cost of registration for the SALA Festival.

Subsidies will be provided to artists who are:

- residents of the City of Burnside who are exhibiting either in or outside of the Council area.
- artists or artist groups exhibiting within the City of Burnside.

Subsidies will only be provided for costs associated with registrations for SALA. Multiple applications may be considered in special circumstances.

The closing date for applications will be **Monday 21 May 2018**. Exact allocation of subsidies will be dependent upon the number of applications received.

The **Rural City of Murray Bridge** will support local artists taking part in the SALA Festival in the Council area by subsidising artist registrations. Artists who do not reside within Murray Bridge but who wish to exhibit in the Council area are also eligible to claim the rebate.

Subsidies are available to assist with the cost of registering for the SALA Festival. Exact amount of subsidy will be dependent upon the number of applications received with a maximum of \$100 for individuals and up to \$250 for groups.

Eligible artists should register with SALA, pay their registration as normal to the SALA office then submit a copy of their receipt along with a completed Application Form. Download the form from the Murray Bridge Gallery website, www.murraybridgegallery.com.au/.

The **City of Holdfast Bay** would like to support and promote emerging and professional artists exhibiting at venues within Holdfast Bay during the 2018 SALA Festival. Subsidies of **\$120** are available to assist individuals and groups with the cost of SALA registrations.

- Allocation of subsidies will be dependent on the number of applications received

The **City of Port Adelaide Enfield (PAE)** is proud to support and promote emerging and professional artists to be involved with the SALA Festival 2018. The City of PAE will provide a 100% subsidy for STANDARD artists registrations for SALA Festival exhibitions and events held within the Council area. Artists do not need to live within the City of Port Adelaide Enfield, but must deliver their exhibition or event within the City.

Eligible artists need to register with SALA, but do not need to pay any registration fee – unless they opt for a premium registration. SALA will invoice the City of Port Adelaide Enfield directly for standard registrations. SALA will invoice artists for the balance in the case of premium registrations.

All artists receiving support from the City of Port Adelaide Enfield are required to display the City of Port Adelaide Enfield logo on any relevant printed material. Contact customer.service@portenf.sa.gov.au for the logo and conditions of use.

The City of Port Adelaide Enfield will produce a PAE SALA Guide featuring all exhibitions and events within the Council area. This will be distributed to all local SALA venues and through Council's Civic Centre, Visitor Information Centre, libraries and community centres. Artists need to email a high resolution (300dpi) image to customer.service@portenf.sa.gov.au with the email subject: "PAE SALA Guide image – Artist Name/Exhibition Name" - All images must be submitted by Friday 15 June 2018.
