

# SALA IN THE PARK

*SALA in the Park* is an outdoor sculpture exhibition that takes place during August in the grounds of Centennial Park. South Australian artists and creatives are invited to submit their outdoor sculptures for consideration. Five artworks will be selected to be exhibited alongside the existing sculptures in the park's permanent collection, and those artists will be paid for the loan of their work.

## Artwork submissions for SALA in the Park (2026):

- are restricted to living South Australian residents who are aged 18 years or older at the time of submission.
  - are open to groups or collectives (but there will be no additional fee paid for group works)
  - close at 11:59 PM Tuesday 31 March 2026.
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By making a submission, **you declare that you understand and agree to the following terms** that will apply if your artwork is selected:

### **1. The artists whose artwork is selected will be required to:**

- a. provide SALA with accurate information about the selected sculpture, including:
  - i. Artwork Title
  - ii. Artist name/s
  - iii. Year of artwork completion
  - iv. Materials
  - v. dimensions (height, width, depth in mm)
  - vi. weight (kg) (note if actual weight or estimate)
  - vii. installation information and method including if pegging is required and the size of pegs required (this assists Centennial Park with selecting the location of sculpture).
  - viii. artist statement about the work (20-50 words).
  - ix. price (if for sale – no commission taken by SALA or by Centennial Park) or advise that the artwork is not for sale.
  - x. Image of the artwork
  - xi. Artist website – optional
- b. deliver the artwork to Centennial Park at own expense between **Monday 13 – Friday 31 July 2026** on a weekday between the hours of 8am-3pm. Artist must contact Centennial Park before Friday 10 July 2026 to arrange a suitable date and time for delivery and installation (one week's notice is preferred) that must be adhered to.
- c. be onsite for install and deinstall and provide own delivery and installation equipment. A Centennial Park team member will be present to assist and conduct

a safety check.

- d. loan the nominated artwork/sculpture for continuous exhibition at Centennial Park from the agreed installation date (prior to 1 August 2026) to the agreed deinstallation date (after 31 August 2026).
  - e. collect/remove the artwork from Centennial Park at own expense between Tuesday 1 – Friday 11 September 2026 on a weekday between the hours of 8am-3pm. Artist must contact Centennial Park by Friday 4 September 2026 to arrange a suitable date and time for collection of the artwork (one week's notice is preferred) that must be adhered to. Sculpture removal may occur after this date and on a weekend if contact has been made with Centennial Park and agreed upon prior.
  - f. secure their own Public Liability Insurance Cover to a minimum limit of \$20,000,000 (standard amount for an artist) for the entire time that the sculpture is at Centennial Park, inclusive of delivery/installation and deinstallation dates and provide a copy of the Certificate of Currency to SALA Festival upon signing this agreement.   - g. either secure insurance for the value of the artwork itself or proceed with the knowledge that the artwork is not covered by insurance for theft or damage, and that Centennial Park and SALA Festival cannot be held liable if this occurs.
  - h. confirm that this insurance policy does not exclude any products or services that the artist is providing Centennial Park.
  - i. To provide an invoice to SALA Festival for the Artist Fee following de-installation of the artwork.
2. Artwork / artist selection will take place following the close of applications. A proposal will be prepared by SALA Staff and ultimate selection made be Centennial Park.
  3. The selection panel's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into following the decision of the panel.
  4. Submitting an artwork for consideration is not a guarantee of success or inclusion in the Centennial Park Sculpture Exhibition.
  5. Successful applicants will be notified the week of Monday 13 April 2026.
  6. Copyright of any submitted images resides with the artist unless otherwise negotiated and agreed upon in writing between all parties, save that by submitting an artwork for consideration, the selected artists hereby grant SA Living Artists Inc. and Centennial Park, irrevocable and perpetual license to copy and/or use the images submitted by you for promotional purposes.
