

Whittles Body Corporate Management Services Venue Award - 2026

For venues that exceeded expectations in supporting artists exhibiting during SALA Festival 2026. This can be in areas such as installation support, promotion of the artist, community engagement, visitor experience, and more. One regional and one metropolitan non-arts* venue will each receive a prize of \$2,000.

Terms & Conditions

- 1) Eligibility
 - a. South Australian venues registered to participate in SALA Festival 2026 are eligible for this award.
 - b. The definition of a 'venue' for the purposes of this award can include physical and online venues, as well as those that are not connected to an organisation (eg, a private garden).
 - c. Venues that operate primarily as an 'art space' are ineligible for this award. (eg. dedicated art galleries, permanent/commercial artist studios)
 - d. Nominated venues must comply with the [SALA Participants' Terms and Conditions](#) and the [SALA First Nations Rights Policy](#).
 - e. Venues that are participating in the festival without their own individual registration are ineligible for this award.
- 2) Entry
 - a. Applications for this award will be accepted via the SALA Online Portal
 - b. Applications will open on 1 July 2026
 - c. Applications will close at 11:59pm Monday 31 August 2026.
 - d. Venues can self-nominate or be nominated by another person.
- 3) Judging
 - a. The award will be judged at the conclusion of SALA Festival 2026 by a panel of judges based on the nomination forms submitted.
 - b. The judges' decision will be final and no further correspondence will be entered into.
- 4) The winner will be announced in the Australian Spring of 2026.
- 5) Employees and associates of SALA Festival and Whittles Body Corporate Management Services are not eligible for the award.
