

The Don Dunstan Foundation Award – 2023

For artists whose work explores social justice themes which align with the objectives and priorities of the Don Dunstan Foundation including homelessness; mental health; migration (including cultural and ethnic diversity); economic equality and justice; Aboriginal economic empowerment and reconciliation; human rights; or Don Dunstan himself.

Prize is \$1,000.

Terms and Conditions:

1. Entry to this award is restricted to persons who meet all of the following criteria:
 - a. are taking part in an exhibition/event registered in the 2023 SALA Festival
 - b. are a living resident of South Australia
2. Entries to this award:
 - a. close at 11:59pm Wednesday 17 May 2023
 - b. are limited to 1 per artist
3. The artwork submitted to this award must:
 - a. be the original work of the artist named in the form
 - b. have been created since the conclusion of the previous SALA Festival (August 2022)
 - c. comply with the SALA Participant Terms & Conditions
 - d. comply with the SALA First Nations Rights Policy
 - e. be destined for exhibition in the 2023 SALA Festival at the specific exhibition/event named in the award form.
4. Judging
 - a. Finalists will be determined prior to the Festival by a panel of judges based on the award nomination forms and will be announced in July.
 - b. The winner/s of the award will be determined by a panel of judges during the 2023 SALA Festival and announced at the conclusion of the Festival. Any changes to the visiting conditions (eg. open dates, open hours) of finalist exhibitions may affect the judging of the finalist work and need to be communicated to the SALA Festival office as early as possible.
 - c. The judges' decision will be final and no further correspondence will be entered into.
5. The winner of the Don Dunstan Foundation Award agrees to have their artwork featured on the cover and/or included in the 2023 Don Dunstan Foundation Annual Report.
6. Copyright of the images resides with the artist unless otherwise negotiated and agreed upon in writing between all parties, save that by submitting this form, you hereby grant SA Living Artists Inc and The Don Dunstan Foundation a free, irrevocable and perpetual licence to copy and/or use the images submitted by you for judging and promotional purposes.
7. Employees and associates of SALA Festival and The Don Dunstan Foundation are not eligible for the award.
8. Please note that this award is non-acquisitive. The winning work will remain the property of the artist.
9. Prize money will be paid to the artist who makes the award application. Artwork created by multiple artists are welcome, however the division of prize money to collaborating artists is the responsibility of the artist who makes the award application.
