Prize: \$5,000 cash.

Terms and Conditions:

- 1) Entry is restricted to artists working with moving image or new media.
- 2) Entry is restricted to living artists residing in South Australia who are 2022 SALA Festival Participants.
- 3) Entries close at 11:59pm Wednesday 18 May 2021.
- 4) The artwork nominated for the award must be exhibited in the 2022 SALA Festival event nominated on the following page.
- 5) Finalists will be determined by a panel of judges prior to the 2022 Festival based on the award nomination forms and will be announced in July.
- 6) Winner/s will be determined by a panel of judges during the 2022 Festival and will be announced at the conclusion of the SALA Festival.
- 7) The artworks entered must have been completed since the conclusion of the 2021 SALA Festival must comply with the SALA Participants' Terms and Conditions and the SALA First Nations Rights Policy.
- 8) Copyright of the images resides with the artist unless otherwise negotiated and agreed upon in writing between all parties, save that by submitting this form, you hereby grant SA Living Artists Inc and UnitCare Services a free, irrevocable and perpetual licence to copy and/or use the images submitted by you for judging and promotional purposes.
- 9) The judges' decision will be final and no further correspondence will be entered into.
- 10) Employees and associates of SALA Festival and UnitCare Services are not eligible for the award.
